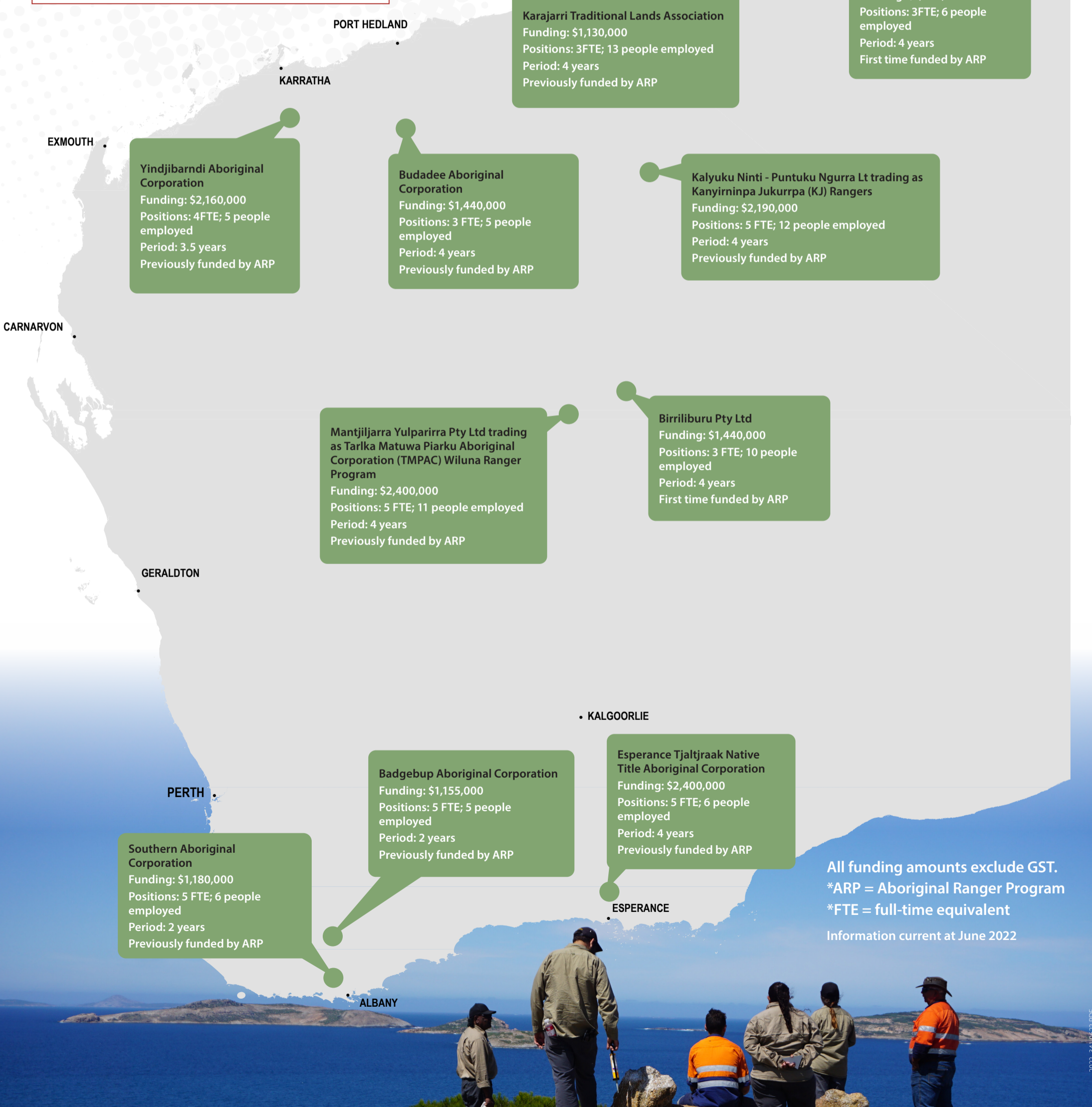




ABORIGINAL RANGER PROGRAM

FOURTH ROUND FUNDING RECIPIENTS – EXPANSION FUND

The McGowan Government is investing **\$22.8 million** across **14 established ranger programs** in Round 4 of the Aboriginal Ranger Program. This funding is supporting **57 full-time equivalent positions**, including **61 full-time and part-time jobs and 40 casual roles**, more than half of which are expected to be filled by women.
