



ABORIGINAL RANGER PROGRAM

PHASE 1 FUNDING RECIPIENTS

Through Phase 1 of the Aboriginal Ranger Program, the State Government invested \$20 million between 2017 and 2023 that supported 28 Aboriginal groups which led to employment for 1236 Aboriginal people, 45 percent being women and 853 people undertaking formal training.
