INTRODUCTION

The Government will deliver more than \$165 million for new and upgraded boating facilities, campgrounds, trails and tourist attractions across Western Australia, to make it easier for more Western Australians to enjoy the State's great outdoors.

The Outdoor and Adventure Tourism package includes \$32.85 million funded through the 2024-25 State Budget for Parks and Wildlife Service to upgrade campgrounds, trails, visitor facilities, the Pemberton Climbing trees and the Penguin Island jetty.

- » Remove dead section from upper part of Gloucester tree and construct new platform.
- Rebuild tower structure in upper tree part of Bicentennial Tree.
- » Investigate potential for a new built tree tower in the Pemberton region.


