



Summer scholarship application

Biodiversity and Conservation Science (BCS) within the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions offers summer scholarships to talented third year and fourth year (Honours) students who intend to progress to postgraduate research, or those transitioning from Honours to a Masters by Research or PhD program. BCS is offering the opportunity for students to undertake a 12 week research project (December – February) with payment of an honorarium of \$8,000. Scholarships will be undertaken in collaboration with a university academic and will be awarded to students who provide a strong intention to undertake postgraduate research with a BCS scientific supervisor.

BCS has a team of scientists that work to support the department’s conservation and management activities and this is an excellent opportunity to gain valuable research experience before commencing a postgraduate project.
